1. YEARBOOK

Session Fee...\$20.00 (Sitting fee only, does not include package prices)

Looking to stick to just the basics? This session covers your school's requirements for submission to their yearbook!







2. FULL SESSION

Session Fee...\$40.00 (Sitting fee only, does not include package prices) This 30 minute session not only captures both the classic Cap & Gown and Tuxedo/Drape poses, but also includes custom props and posing to give the senior and their family options beyond the yearbook required portrait!









3. DELUXE SESSION

Session Fee...\$50.00 (Sitting fee only, does not include package prices) Showcase your style! Let us capture what makes you, **you**. The Deluxe session is a 45 minute session that includes the classic Cap & Gown poses, formal Tuxedo/Drape portraits, and a casual outfit of your choice. Portraits are taken both indoor and outdoors at our studio. We have creative scenes designed to show off your personality. We encourage our seniors to bring in personal items that speak to their unique high school career!









Barberito Tips & Tricks

- 1. Do not be afraid to think outside the box! We want to authentically capture who you are right now as you prepare to graduate!
- 2. Remember, texture, patterns, and color will make your portraits POP! Make sure to bring some colorful wardrobe options.
- 3. Dress head to toe! This includes hair, nails, shoes, the whole nine yards.

 Details go a long way into creating a portrait unique to you.
- 4. Bring a few of your favorite things! Think sports uniforms or jerseys, statement jackets, fun jewelry, etc. Time permitting, our photographers love to create portraits that stand out.
- 5. Can't decide on what to wear? Bring options to our studio! Our photographers are happy to help style you in a way most flattering to you.
- 6. Tan lines are costly to remove. Avoid sunburn or being overly tanned before your
- 7. portrait session. If this is not possible, consider wearing clothing that will disguise the tan lines.
- 8. Ladies, make sure you have the appropriate undergarments for each outfit.
- 9. You should come fully prepared to your session which means hair and makeup complete. We want to use all of your session time towards photographing you!
- Gentlemen, make sure to come clean-shaven or make sure your beard is trimmed up.
